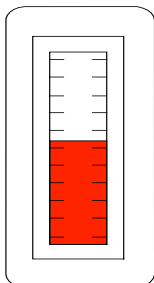
Departure Times between 10:00 am and Noon

Trail Ride Rules and Guidelines

Note: The safety and wellbeing of all riders and horses are of paramount importance, particularly in an event of this size.

Please carefully read the following rules and guidelines before signing the waiver. If you have any questions please direct them to the registration table.

All riders must be registered before leaving on the trail ride. A minimum of **\$20.00** in pledges is required for each ride. If a rider has no pledges, a ride fee of **\$20.00** will be charged. Please ensure that your name and complete address is on your pledge sheet. Registration will be Sunday morning from 9:00 am until Noon.

We will offer a poker rally at the day camp as well as out on the ride for non-riders to enjoy.

The Trail Boss has the right to reject and expel any rider who disrupts the ride. All riders must ride on marked trails.

All riders must obey trail etiquette and ride rules or they will be asked to return to base camp. The ride is on private land, therefore, **no smoking or drinking** will be permitted on the trail and riders are responsible for carrying their own garbage for disposal in refuse containers at the base camp.

Children under the age of 14 must be under the supervision of a responsible adult.

No stallions or foals at mare's side will be allowed on the ride.

Dogs will not be allowed on the trail. If it is necessary for dogs to attend the ride, they must be kept on a leash and under strict control.

Feed and transportation are the responsibility of the rider. Please do not allow your horse to graze. Water for your horses will be available at the ride site.

Please Note: Helmets are recommended for your safety.

Please check in at the registration table when you return so we know everyone is back safe.

Waiver of Responsibility

If for some reason, beyond the control of the RUMSEY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY, the ride is cancelled, the RUMSEY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY will not be liable in any way.
